

HUMBERSIDE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT



Project Description:

The project included an previous extension of the existing terminal building at Humberside International Airport for Humberside County Council, along with internal remodelling and alterations to create a new main entrance, shopping area, domestic departures and arrivals area, check in facilities and office accommodation.

The works also included the upgrade of the electricity supply to the site. Heating was provided using heat pumps serving a ducted warm air system to the main hall with local electric panel heaters in offices and similar areas.

The project won the Yorkshire Electricity Beta Award. Electrical systems included lighting, emergency lighting, power, fire alarms and security systems.

The new building was predominantly fair faced brickwork with concealed services and exposed roof steelwork and ductwork at high level.
