Project Description:

The project was to remodel an existing car showroom, furniture and motor cycle shops to provide a larger more prominent car sales showroom, general motor vehicle workshop, MOT bay, stores, welfare facilities etc. The whole project had to be carried out whilst the motor dealership and workshop carried on business as usual.

The electrical services included mains distribution, lighting, power, data and telecommunications, fire alarms, security & CCTV.

The mechanical services included direct gas fired units for the workshop with heat pump/air conditioning for the showroom and LPHW heating to other areas. The scheme also included air supply and extract ventilation, domestic hot and cold water services, gas and compressed air services and a vehicle exhaust extraction system.
